Being a father himself, Steve Weeks' children's music comes naturally and directly from the heart. Described as "simple, elegant songwriting with a heavy dose of whimsy", his songs are warm-hearted and melodic with clever lyrics that appeal to parents and kids alike.

Although his music has a strong footing in folk, his songs cover a wide and eclectic range of styles. You're just as likely to come across African rhythms, rock riffs, reggae bass lines, banjo solos, or zany sound effects in a Steve Weeks tune as you are to hear the acoustic guitar. Whatever you encounter on his CDs, you can be sure that it's Steve – a one-man band, he performs all the instruments and vocals on his creations.

Alphabet Songs has garnered NAPPA Honors and Parents' Choice Recommended awards and can consistently be found on the XM Kids Top 13 Under 13, the only national children's music chart, where the song "Kiki Kangaroo" reached the number 1 position.

Alphabet Songs Vol. III is the third and final CD in the Alphabet Songs series, and like the previous two volumes, it dedicates a single song to each letter, covering the letters R through Z.

The music is upbeat, acoustic-based and catchy. From the bluegrass title track "Rabbit Run" to the pop-rock "William" to the African inspired "Zed and Zoey" the songs cover a broad range of musical styles. As always, the songs offer a positive message, a challenging tongue-twister or just a plain old good story.

The song "Someday" from this CD reached the #1 position on XM Kids (XM Radio channel 116), and the song "Up!" won first place in the Children's category of the 2007 USA Songwriting Competition.
